Notice of Race

1 Organizing Authority

The Organizing Authority (OA) will be Amwaj Al Bahar Sport Equipment Rental LLC ("SeaYou").

2 Venue

Venue of the event will be on Palm Jumeirah, Dubai, UAE. Exact location will be sent to participants by email 2 days before the race.

3 Rules

Challenge will sail under current Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), ISAF and The Notice of Race.

4 Racing Area

The racing area will be a 5 minutes sail away from the launching area.

5 Courses to be sailed

The courses to be sailed will be mentioned at the briefing.

6 Competing Classes:

R300 Class windsurfing race: open to Bic Sport Techno 293 OD, Neil Pryde RS:One, Starboard Phantom 295, Surfers Group 272 Sportsman.

This race is part of the 2015-2016 UAE National Phantom295 Class.

8 Equipment

- Competitors are permitted to using sails and rigs approved by the R300 class only.
- Phantom295 charter boards/sails/rigs will be allocated at random by the Race Committee.

9 Eligibility and fees

The race entry is open to everyone. 1/3 of participants should be UAE national, 1/3 of participants should be female. Beginners are NOT accepted. Knowing how to swim is mandatory.

Entrance fee: FREE for all participants and supporters.

Charter equipment: StarBoard Phantom295, AED 100 for board and complete rig 6.5sqm or 7.5sqm or 8.5sqm.

There are only limited amount of charter equipment. Please reserve as soon as possible.

10 Safety

All competitors should know how to swim. Life vest is mandatory and will be available on safety boat if necessary.

11 Trophies and prizes

- Overall: 1st, 2nd, 3rd
- Female: 1st

12 Media, images and sound

If required by the OA, teams shall carry media personnel and/or equipment supplied by the OA on board while racing. The OA have the right to use, without any restrictions, any images and sound recorded during the event free of any charge.

13 Disclaimer of liability

Competitors will participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See ISAF RRS 4; "Decision to Race". The competitor is entirely responsible for his own safety, whether afloat or ashore and nothing, whether in the Notice of Race or Sailing Instructions or anywhere else, reduces these responsibilities. It is for the competitor to decide whether the boat is fit to sail in the conditions in which they find themselves. By launching or going to the sea, the competitor confirms that the boat is fit for those conditions and the crew is competent to sail and compete in them.
